

SRS 2:1 Sheave Shackle



The SRS 2:1 Sheave Shackle has been in testing in some of the toughest conditions that are experienced in sailing. Tested on yachts of up to 60' in length in races on the Australian East Coast from the Sydney to Hobart Classic to Hamilton Island Race week.

The SRS Sheave Shackle body is made from investment cast 17/4 Ph Stainless Steel, whilst there are two options for the sheave "Wearon" for most applications or for a high load situation sintered brass sheaves have been used.

The shackle pin is captive in the shackle using the double thread system on the pin. On our non-certified testing we have found that we are starting to get some pin deformation at approx. 7600kgs.

Yachts that have used the SRS Sheave Shackles are the two Farr 52s "Hollywood Boulevard" & "Ichi Barn", The IMS 50s such as Ragamuffin, Sting and Yendys. The shackle has also been used on the Open 66 "Broomstick" and Sydney 60 "Eureka" the Lyons Cause 60 "Vanguard". The shackle is also in use on international yachts such as the Welbourne 47 "Hi Fidelity" and the Sayer 43 "Sayonara".
