Comments:

An upgrade from the 60' Cantling keel Wild Oats (now Wild Joe), Wild Oats 66 was launched in July 2004 & shipped directly to Sardinia to compete in the Maxi Worlds. All running rigging on Wild Oats is supplied by Sydney Rigging Specialists, a mix of Dynex Cores with overbraiding by Donaghys & "Bluetech" is used on "Wild Oats 66". Various cover combinations have been used through out the package ranging from 100% PBO (Elite) on the runner tails, a vectran/kevlar mix (Precision) on the mainsheet & Kevlar/ Polyester (performance) on jib sheets & spinnaker sheets. Wild Oats 66 recently won IRC at the 2005 Hamilton Island race week. Currently a new 98' (30m) is under construction & Sydney Rigging Specialists are supplying the running rigging for the new "Wild Oats 98" to be launched in December 2005.
